The Upside Down Kingdom: Murder by Anger

Matthew 5:21-26

Here is your kingdom practice for the week. Remember that transformation happens when we go beyond just information and actually practice and reflect on what we're learning. Discipleship is about getiting into action!

Kingdom Practice



"If you enter your place of worship and, about to make an offering, you suddenly remember a grudge a friend has against you, abandon your offering, leave immediately, go to this friend and make things right." - Matthew 5:23-24

With God's help, take one step towards forgiving someone who has hurt you. Or ask for forgiveness from someone whom you've hurt. If possible, take the initiative to be reconciled to that person or repair the relationship. (Note: reconciliation is not always possible, nor may it be advisable in cases where abuse is involved. You may want to talk to a pastor or counselor first).
