Challenge Ideas

(no matter where you are at, go one step further)

- 1) Do a devotional with family or friends at meal time (consider using the Generosity devotional). Discuss what it means to live generous lives in response to God's grace.
- 2) Make a list of all the ways God has been generous to you and "count your blessings." Spend time each day giving God thanks. Ask God how he wants you to be a faithful steward of these blessings.
- 3) Move towards someone who is different from you or difficult for you and make an effort to get to know them and hear their story. Go beyond your preconcieved opinions and see them as an image-bearer of God.
