Whereas happiness is based on circumstances and getting life to go the way you want, joy is much deeper and more substantial. Joy is something we can experience and live with no matter what happens.

Today **Ben Vos** will explore with us Philippians 4:1-9. As Paul closes the letter, he encourages the Philippians to rejoice regardless of circumstances, and to pray about everything...with joy. Practicing these two habits is the only surefire way to keep anxiety and fear and the unknown in their place. We don't ignore those things, because life is full of them and we need to be responsible to think through our present and future. But rejoicing and praying with thanksgiving reminds us of God's sovereignty, and of how much He's already done for us to ensure that we get to be in heaven and that we get to have peace on earth until that day. Are you struggling with worry or fear or anxiety? Count your blessings, talk to God about everything, and watch how God blesses your vulnerability with His peace.
