Write your own Psalm based on the form of Psalm 23 that reflects your unique relationship with the Lord; (i.e. sheep to the shepherd; house to a foundation; branch to the vine; disciple to teacher; etc.)

- vs. 1 Who is God in relation to me in two phrases
- vs. 2 Where He put me in two phrases
- vs. 3 The walk I have with him in two phrases
- vs. 4 Potential danger and His protection in three phrases.
- vs. 5 God's provision, in three phrases
- vs. 6 My future in relation to this special relationship with God, in two phrases

Personal 23rd Psalm (example)
