Resilient Faith: Running in God's Armor

Today we conclude our sermon series on Paul's letter to the Christians in Ephesus. But here's the good news: God has already defeated the devil and the powers of darkness in the person and work of Jesus! And we are called to stand firm against the devil's schemes by putting on God's armor. In this final sermon on "resilient faith," **Pastor Brian Keepers** will explore with us the different parts of this armor and how we might put all the pieces on as we "fight the good fight, finish the race, and keep the faith" (2 Tim.4:7).
