Refuel: The Blessing and the Limp

Our bodies need fuel to move and work. For the Christ follower, our soul finds nourishment in Scripture. This summer, we're engaging passages of Scripture that have been transformational for our preaching team and congregation. Whether today's passage is one you're hearing for the first time or one you've heard one hundred times, we invite you to feed on God's Word, that it may metabolize into outward acts of faithfulness, love and justice.

While the Bible is food for our soul, not every part of the Bible is easy to swallow. As the the angel told the Apostle John when he instructed him to eat the scroll, God's Word is "sweet in the the mouth," but sometimes it is "bitter in the stomach" (Rev. 10:9-10). Today **Pastor Brian Keepers** will explore with us one of those stories in the Bible that may be more bitter in the stomach—the story of Jacob wrestling with God (Genesis 32:22-31). This story gives us a picture of God that is different than what we expect. And yet as we'll see, this is a hopeful story about how God's grace transforms us and makes us new.
