FALL 2021 DISCIPLESHIP PATHWAYS

ROOTED: Rooted is a small group community experience where people practice seven rhythms essential to a healthy relationship with Jesus. Rooted is for those ready to engage the foundations of following Jesus as disciple, for new members and for those ready to engage an initial Trinity group experience. Participants engage and reflect on daily Scripture, readings and questions, coming together to share within their group what God is showing them. 10 consecutive weeks; Sunday mornings from 10:15am – 11:15pm; September 19 - November 21 in the Front Room; Facilitated by Rik and Amy Dahl; Registration deadline is September 16.

THE JOURNEY/VP 3: An uncommon, faith-deepening and life-aligning process guided by three primary questions: Who is God? Who am I? What does God desire to do through me? The Journey meets as a small group gathering, walking together for 21 weeks through regular study, reflection, Bible reading and prayer for. The Journey meets Wednesday weekly, October 6 – November 17; January 12 – February 23; March 16 – April 27; OC Campus, 6:30-8:00pm, Adult Room 2. Cost for materials is \$250. \$50 due at registration with balance to be paid. Trinity invests \$50 per participant. Facilitated by Adam Boone and Michelle Christy, Director of Adult Discipleship. Registration open to both campuses until September 27.

FAITHWALKING MODULE 1: Awareness through Self Discovery:

Faithwalking is a process of spiritual formation that believes wholeness is possible. Participants are equipped with tools to gain freedom from wounds of the past, grow in emotional maturity and live lives of purpose on mission with God. Engage regular solitude, Scripture, journaling and weekly skills practice. Begins September 22, with two options: Wednesdays at 6:30pm in-person at Hospers Campus facilitated and coached by Pastor Kurt Bush, co-facilitator to be determined; Wednesday noon hour via Zoom from 11:45am – 1:00pm, with hybrid zoom/in-person coaching facilitated by Pastor Brian and Michelle Christy, Director of Adult Discipleship. Cost is \$100. Trinity invests \$50 per participant. \$50 due at registration. Registration open to both campuses until September 15.

The Old Testament book of Nehemiah is a story about God's faithfulness to bring His people, Israel, home after a long period of exile. God calls two key leaders, Nehemiah and the priest Ezra, to rebuild the holy temple and the wall of Jerusalem, which lay in ruins. Even more importantly, these two leaders are called to join God in rebuilding a holy people—a covenant community that remembers who and whose they are, as well as their calling to be a light to the nations. So, as the body of Christ, we are called to rise up and join God's work of building for His kingdom. Ultimately, God is building us into a kingdom people for His glory and for the sake of the world.
