The Old Testament book of Nehemiah is a story about God's faithfulness to bring His people, Israel, home after a long period of exile. God calls two key leaders, Nehemiah and the priest Ezra, to rebuild the holy temple and the wall of Jerusalem, which lay in ruins. Even more importantly, these two leaders are called to join God in rebuilding a holy people–a covenant community that remembers who and whose they are, as well as their calling to be a light to the nations. So, as the body of Christ we are called to rise up and join God's work of building for His kingdom. Ultimately, God is building us into a kingdom people for His glory and for the sake of the world.

Rise and Rebuild: "Facing Opposition From Within"

Last Sunday we saw how God's people faced external opposition. Sanballat and Tobiah and their allies attacked from outside the walls. Today, as we engage Nehemiah Chapter 5, **Pastor Brian Keepers** will explore with us how opposition to God's work among his people wasn't just external; it also came from within.
