### WELCOME!

The Old Testament book of Nehemiah is a story about God's faithfulness to bring His people, Israel, home after a long period of exile. God calls two key leaders, Nehemiah and the priest Ezra, to rebuild the holy temple and the wall of Jerusalem, which lay in ruins. Even more importantly, these two leaders are called to join God in rebuilding a holy people—a covenant community that remembers who and whose they are, as well as their calling to be a light to the nations. So, as the body of Christ we are called to rise up and join God's work of building for His kingdom. Ultimately, God is building us into a kingdom people for His glory and for the sake of the world.

#### "God's Word Re-stories and Restores His People"

The rebuilding of Jerusalem's wall is complete, in fifty-two days no less. Now protected and free, God's people gather to worship. The people ask for God's word, the Book of the Law. So, Ezra, the priest and scribe, brings the word to the people. God's word falls afresh and anew. Today, **Michelle Christy**, Director of Adult Discipleship, unpacks the text as we hear and see God's people request his word, read his word, rejoice in his word, and respond to his word. Through the work of the word, God's people are re-storied and restored. In what really has been for them a second exodus, not unlike the first Exodus, God's word comes to his people reminding and rebuilding them as God's treasured possession. They are re-built, a spiritual house as a dwelling of the Lord and light to the nations.
