TODAY'S MESSAGE

"Treasure in Jars of Clay"

Today our Director of Adult Discipleship, **Michelle Christy**, explores what the Apostle Paul calls treasure in jars of clay in 2 Corinthians 4:5-12. As Paul faces judgment and discredit, alongside hardship and suffering, he does not point to or proclaim himself, but to the power of Christ at work in and through broken human beings. In fact, Paul likens the display of God's Spirit and power through human beings as treasure in jars of clay. Often in our brokenness, woundedness and pain we fail to see how God works in and through us. Yet it is those very things that allow the Light of God to shine through the cracks of our being and point to Someone greater. This is treasure—that God chooses to inhabit His people to bring the message of restoration and redemption in Christ to a hurting world.
