BLOOD DRIVE | APRIL 1

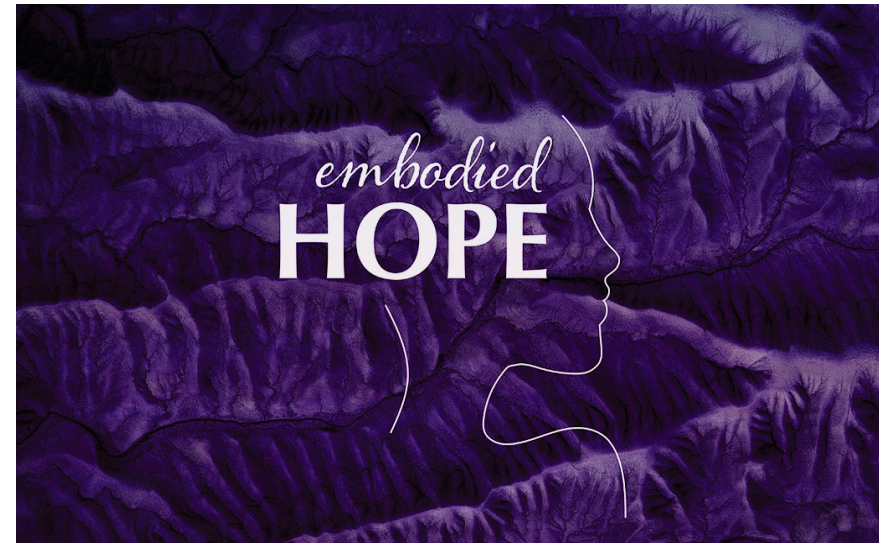
