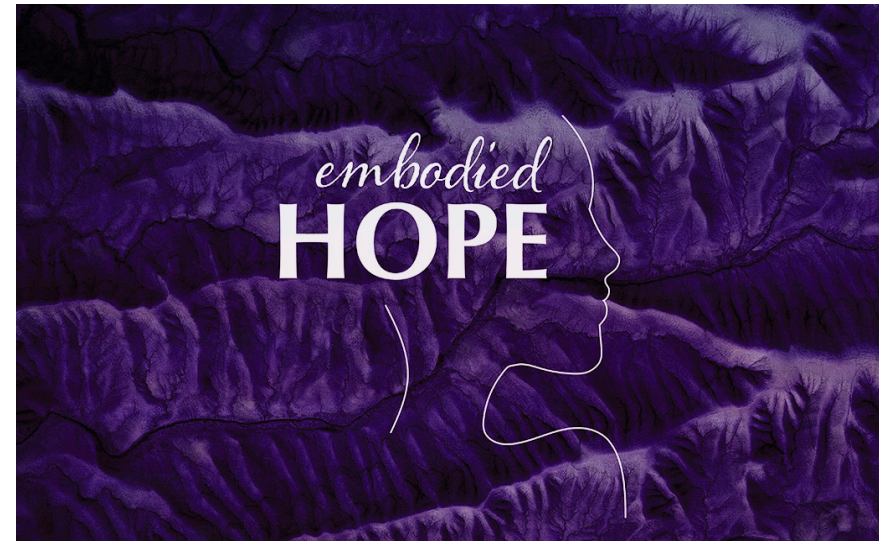
FINANCIAL UPDATE
