

TODAY'S MESSAGE

"Pursuing Sexual Wholeness"

Today as we continue our sermon series on what it means to be embodied creatures who bear God's image, **Pastor Brian Keepers** will explore with us the important but often difficult topic of sex and sexuality. To be embodied is to be a sexual being. Engaging Paul's words in 1 Corinthians 6:9-20, we will explore three different attitudes towards sex and sexuality, using the image of food and dieting: the starvation diet, the fast-food diet, and the banquet. What we will see is that sexual desire, like all our deepest longings, ultimately finds its fulfillment in God and in healthy relationships.
